2. SELECTION PROCESS

Students who have obtained Bachelor's Degree (studied in 10+2+3 system) in any discipline from a recognized University with not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate and having studied Kannada as an optional subject/ Language at undergraduate level and having secured a minimum of 50% marks or equivalent grade. Up to 5% relaxation in minimum requirement of marks is granted to SC/ST candidates. The candidates should not have completed 25 years of age as on admission year.

Admission to MA Kannada course shall be based on a entrance test conducted by CUCET. Process of admission, programme structure, registration , evaluation, declaration of results, award of degree and other particulars mentioned in the "REGULATIONS FOR POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES UNDER CHOICE BASED CREDIT AN SEMESTER SYSTEM (CBCS)", Central University of Kerala shall be applicable to the students securing admission for MA at the Department of Kannada.

Any modifications on the above mentioned regulations at any period during the course shall also be valid on the students.
